Happy New Year and welcome back to school!

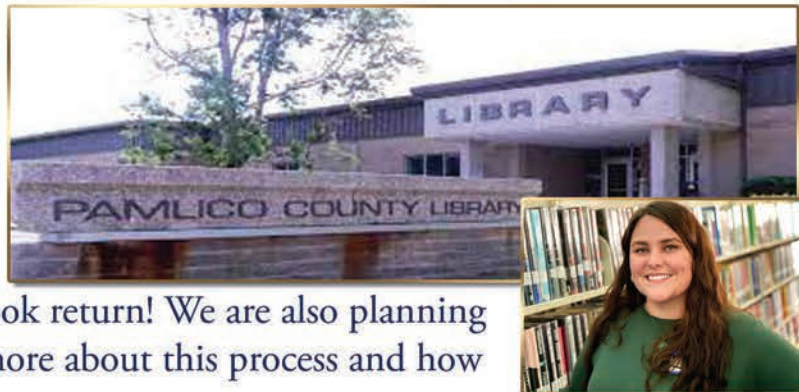
